Public Consultation on the Regulations for Implementation and Protection of Infrastructure July 2022

Preamble

Driven by CITC's role towards maintenance of public interest and maintenance of telecommunication and information technology infrastructure, CITC has prepared a draft "Regulations for Implementation and Protection of Infrastructure" that includes a number of obligations that must be observed to raise quality of implementation and protection of infrastructure works in order to avoid causing damage to public telecommunication networks.

Objectives

This document is the first draft regulations for implementation and protection of telecommunication and information technology infrastructure in the Kingdom that aims to raise quality of implementation of infrastructure works, achieve the optimal utilization of limited resources allocated for infrastructure facilities, set governance of and synchronize applications for coordination of excavation and applications for migration and transfer of infrastructure to facilitate implementation of various service projects, in addition to protecting and avoiding causing damage to or interruption of public telecommunication networks in order to ensure continuity and quality of telecommunication and information technology services.
